On leaving the urinary bladder, urine passes through the urethra, which conducts the urine to the exterior. • The urinary bladder and the urethra are responsible for the elimination of urine, a process called urination or micturition. In this process, contraction of the muscular urinary bladder forces urine through the urethra and out of the body.

Adult size = ~ 4 1/2 inches long, 2 1/2 inches wide, 1 inch thick. Nephroptosis = floating kidney. May cause kink in ureter, block urine flow and damage kidney.
